

## **Opportunity for Field biologist for Occupancy Survey in Satpura-Melghat Wildlife Corridor**

### **Description**

Wildlife Research and Conservation Society (WRCS) is engaged in research studies on wildlife and wildlife conservation projects ([www.wrscindia.org](http://www.wrscindia.org)). We are planning to carry out an occupancy survey in the corridor between Satpura Tiger Reserve and Melghat Tiger Reserve. Applications are invited for two posts of Field Biologist for carrying out this survey.

The applicant should be familiar with field protocols of wildlife surveys, including sign surveys and camera trapping. They should have previous experience of working in the field and carrying out similar surveys. Knowledge of GIS is important. They should be capable of carrying out data analysis in statistical packages. The applicant should be fluent in English and should have good report writing skills. Good knowledge about issues regarding management and conservation of wildlife is desirable.

The survey will be carried out in tough field conditions on foot. The candidate should be physically fit and willing to work for long hours in the field for carrying out the survey. It will be necessary to walk at least 15 kilometres daily while carrying out the survey.

Ability to drive 4-wheel vehicle in the field will be an advantage.

### **Educational qualification**

Preference will be given to candidates with an M.Sc. degree.

### **Terms**

The duration of the assignment is 15 months. Salary will be commensurate with qualification and experience. Basic accommodation will be provided at the field site. The applicant must commit to working for the entire duration of the assignment.
